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
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## GREAT MIGRATION - TANZANIA IN 10 DAYS

In the northern reaches of Tanzania one can find some of the world's greatest spectacles of nature - the Great Migration as well as the iconic Ngorongoro crater. Join us as we explore this northern route in Tanzania, discover four national parks and witness some of the greatest sights in the natural kingdom.

Two million wildebeest, one million zebra and so much more - forced to continuously move in a big circular route as they chase the smell of rain and the promise of good grazing. It goes without saying that the predator action never lets us down and the landscape is ideal for photography. One of the hardest things to capture is the magnitude of it all.





# GREAT MIGRATION ITINERARY

## DAY 1: ARUMERU (ARUSHA)

Transfer from Kilimanjaro International Airport to Arusha Town (1 hour). As most flights land very late afternoon or at night, we spend our first night close by so you can recover from your flights. Should your flight land early enough we can modify this to head straight out to Tarangire.

**OVERNIGHT:** Arumeru River Lodge OR Rivertrees Country Inn  
**MEALS:** Dinner  
**INCLUDED:** Transfers from Kilimanjaro to lodge  
**EXCLUDED:** Visa if required

## DAY 2: TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

After a leisurely breakfast we depart to Tarangire National Park. Tarangire has the greatest concentration of wildlife in Tanzania and in dry season the Tarangire River is a magnet for thirsty wildlife. Large herds of elephants and migratory wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, impala, gazelle, hartebeest and eland gather. Not surprisingly, the predators follow. This is also the one place in Tanzania where dry-country antelope such as oryx and gerenuk are regularly spotted. Tarangire is also known for its spectacular baobab trees and its breath-taking views of the Masai Steppe and the mountains to the south.

**OVERNIGHT:** Maramboi Tented camp  
**MEALS:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner  
**INCLUDED:** NP fees and Afternoon game drive

## DAY 3: TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

Today we enjoy a morning and afternoon game drive in Tarangire National Park, returning to the lodge for lunch and to relax a little in the heat of the day. In the afternoon the lodge offers an optional walk to the lake escorted by a Masai – a great experience, a chance to meet a Masai warrior and stretch your legs. Should you choose to do the walk your Afternoon game drive will start and return earlier than normal.

**OVERNIGHT:** Maramboi Tented camp  
**MEALS:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner  
**INCLUDED:** NP fees and Morning and Afternoon game drive with optional walk

## DAY 4: MANYARA NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast we depart with a picnic lunch to Manyara National Park for a full day game drive.

After the full day drive in the park, we head toward the rim of the Rift Valley with phenomenal views to Lake Manyara. Spend the night at the edge of the Ngorongoro concession.

**OVERNIGHT:** Ngorongoro Farm House, Farm House Valley  
**MEALS:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner  
**INCLUDED:** NP fees and Full day drive in Manyara NP

## DAY 5: NGORONGORO CRATER

After breakfast depart with a packed picnic lunch to Ngorongoro Crater for a full day's game drive. Descend into the crater to view game on the vast grasslands of the crater floor. Spectacular animal life can be found throughout the year due to the permanent availability of grass and water. This is one of the world's most iconic wildlife experiences.

**OVERNIGHT:** Masek Tented Camp  
**MEALS:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner  
**INCLUDED:** Full day game drive in Ngorongoro Crater and NP fees



### **DAY 5 & 6: NGORONGORO**

Today, experience the best of two world renowned conservation areas, as we enjoy a morning and afternoon drive in either Ngorongoro and/or Serengeti, returning to the lodge with it's stunning views of Lake Masek.

**OVERNIGHT:** Masek Tented Camp  
**MEALS:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner  
**INCLUDED:** Morning and Afternoon game drives in Ngorongoro Crater and/or Serengeti, NP fees

### **DAY 7,8 & 9: SERENGETI**

After breakfast we enter and make our way to the central Serengeti. Each day there will be a morning and afternoon game drive. Should we wish to range further on one of the days, we can take a picnic lunch and enjoy a full day drive.

*NOTE: We have chosen the central Serengeti for this itinerary but, depending on where the migration is at this stage, we will head there. If it's not in the centre area of the Serengeti we will move to wherever it is - the accommodation will change and there may be a slight price adjustment.*

**OVERNIGHT:** Kati Kati Tented camp  
**MEALS:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner  
**INCLUDED:** Morning and Afternoon game drives in the Serengeti, NP fees

### **DAY 10: END**

After breakfast we start our trip back to the airport, taking in the sights along the way. You may choose to fly back to Kilimanjaro International (optional flight US\$240 pp) or continue your adventure with BushBaby Safaris with a few days in Zanzibar to learn about the slave routes and explore the spice markets, or cross to Kenya to take in the Masai Mara.

**MEALS:** Breakfast  
**INCLUDED:** Transfer by road back to Arusha/Kilimanjaro International  
**EXCLUDED:** Optional return flight and or extensions
