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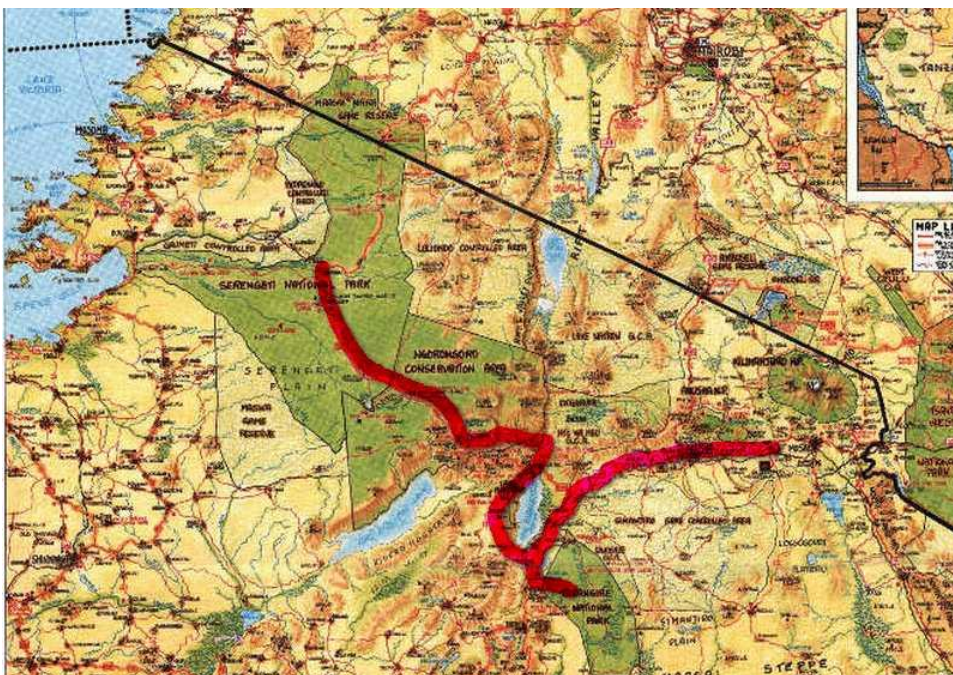
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GREAT MIGRATION - TANZANIA IN 11 DAYS

In the northern reaches of Tanzania one can find some of the world's greatest spectacles of nature - the Great Migration as well as the iconic Ngorongoro crater. Join us as we explore this northern route in Tanzania, discover four national parks and witness some of the greatest sights in the natural kingdom.

Upto four million wildebeest, two million zebra and so much more - forced to continuously move in a big circular route as they chase the smell of rain and the promise of good grazing. It goes without saying that the predator action never lets us down and the landscape is ideal for photography. One of the hardest things to capture is the magnitude of it all.





GREAT MIGRATION ITINERARY

DAY 1: RIVER TREES LODGE

Transfer from Kilimanjaro International Airport to River Trees Lodge (1 hour). As most flights land very late at night, we spend our first night close by so you can recover from your flights.

OVERNIGHT: River Trees Lodge
INCLUDED: Transfers from Kilimanjaro to lodge
EXCLUDED: Visa if required

DAY 2: TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

After a leisurely breakfast we depart to Tarangire National Park. Tarangire has the greatest concentration of wildlife in Tanzania and in dry season the Tarangire River is a magnet for thirsty wildlife. Large herds of elephants and wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, impala, gazelle, hartebeest and eland gather. Not surprisingly, the predators follow. Tarangire is also known for its spectacular baobab trees and its breath-taking views of the Masai Steppe and the mountains to the south.

We will head straight into Tarangire and enjoy a packed lunch in the park while exploring the parks great fauna and flora

Check into camp around sunset with dinner.

OVERNIGHT: Maramboi Tented camp
MEALS: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner
INCLUDED: NP fees and Afternoon game drive





DAY 3: **TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK**

Full day in the park to explore and to find all the treasures. This park is not only home to a large variety of mammals, but also has an incredibly high number of bird species, making it a birders dream.

An option walk from the camp to Lake Manyara is on offer, and is a great opportunity to stretch your legs and to view some wildlife on foot. The walk is led by a Massai Warrior, and is a good time to ask question and to learn a little about the Massai culture.

OVERNIGHT: Maramboi Tented camp
MEALS: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner
INCLUDED: NP fees Full day game drive, walk to lake Manyara.

DAY 4: **MANYARA NATIONAL PARK**

After breakfast we depart with a picnic lunch to Manyara National Park for a full day game drive. Lake Manyara National park is famous for the Lions that climb trees, but for me it's the huge flocks of birds around the lake that make it so special. Flocks of hundreds perhaps thousands of birds like Flamingo, Storks or Pelicans can be seen if you're lucky - and we normally are.

After the full day drive in the park, we head toward the rim of the Rift Valley with phenomenal views to Lake Manyara. Spend the night at the edge of the Ngorongoro concession.

OVERNIGHT: Ngorongoro Farm House
MEALS: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner
INCLUDED: NP fees and Full day drive in Manyara NP

DAY 5: **NGORONGORO CRATER**

After breakfast depart with a packed picnic lunch to Ngorongoro Crater for a morning game drive. Descend into the crater to view game on the vast grasslands of the crater floor. Spectacular animal life can be found throughout the year due to the permanent availability of grass and water. This is one of the world's most iconic wildlife experiences. After lunch we leave the crater and travel out of the crater and to our lodge. A long day but one you are likely to never forget.

OVERNIGHT: Masek Tented Camp
MEALS: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner
INCLUDED: Full day game drive in Ngorongoro Crater and NP fees





DAY 6: **NGORONGORO**

Experience the best of two world renowned conservation areas, as we enjoy a morning and afternoon drive in either Ngorongoro and/or Serengeti, returning to the lodge with stunning views of Lake Masek. The benefit of the way we have structured this tour is that we will be able to move between the two parks depending on wildlife sightings. There are no fences separating the parks. It's very frustrating watching an animal walk over the imaginary line that separates the two parks and now there is no need to stop as the animal walks off without us.

The benefit of the Ngorongoro side is that we may venture off road to get close to special sightings.

OVERNIGHT: Masek Tented Camp

MEALS: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

INCLUDED: Morning and Afternoon game drives in Ngorongoro Crater and/or Serengeti, NP fees



DAY 7 - 9: **SERENGETI**

After breakfast we enter and make our way to the central Serengeti. Each day there will be a morning and afternoon game drive. Should we wish to range further on one of the days, we can take a picnic lunch and enjoy a full day drive.

Day 1 We will take a packed lunch with us and will stop along the way for a picnic, while day 2 and 3 we will conduct morning and afternoon drives, each of which will be about 3 to 4 hours long.

Kati Kati is a mobile tented camp but offers all the comfort of a permanent camp like en-suite facilities. Power is solar power. Most of the camps offer Wi-Fi but this one doesn't due to it being a mobile camp. Below are two pictures of the camp.

INCLUDED: Morning and Afternoon game drives in the Serengeti, NP fees

DAY 10:
FARM HOUSE

After breakfast we make our way back through the southern Serengeti and Ngorongoro wildlife conservation areas and spend the night in The Farm House. Along the way we will stop at a Masai Village for an optional visit. The cost of this optional visit is US\$10 per person and will give you an in site into the daily life of a Masai.

An option to catch a flight back to Arusha is available, please ask for the price.

MEALS: Breakfast
EXCLUDED: Optional Air transfers and Extensions to Zanzibar.

DAY 11:
END

After breakfast we make our way back to Kilimanjaro International by road. We will make a stop at a tourist market to give everybody a chance to buy some curios.

MEALS: Breakfast
INCLUDED: Road transfer flights back to Arusha/Kilimanjaro International
