Day 2 – Delhi sightseeing


Today, after our leisurely breakfast, we head out for a day of sightseeing/photography of Delhi.

After lunch, visit Bharatpur Bird Sanctuary. One of the best reserve parks for avifauna in the world, the Sanctuary is paradise for bird lovers. A safari in the Bharatpur Bird Sanctuary is an alluring and refreshing experience in the tranquility of nature, with melodious birds chirping everywhere. Now known as Keoladeo Ghana National Park, the park is among few protected parks, conserving hundreds of unique bird species.
